Please note that any absence during term-time must be applied for in advance by completion of the "Application for Leave of Absence Form" which is available from the school office or from the school website <a href="www.pendle.lancs.sch.uk">www.pendle.lancs.sch.uk</a>. The School's Governors have agreed that all holidays in term time will be treated as unauthorised absence. Cheaper holidays are not an acceptable reason for leave in term-time.

Please note: the threshold at which a penalty notice will be issued at 10 sessions (equivalent of 5 days) within a rolling 10 school week period. A school week is any week in which a school meets at least once.

Ensuring your child's regular attendance at school is your legal responsibility and permitting absence from school without a good reason creates an offence in law and may result in prosecution.
