Remember to pack at least **2 pairs of spares** in here, even if your child is not prone to 'accidents'. Please let us know if you require support to provide these as we often have spares.

Please also ensure you have been onto Cool Milk to register your child for free school milk. It is useful to have a reminder set a week before your child's 5^{th} birthday to reregister dependent upon whether your child would like to continue having milk.

All other information can be found in the Induction Booklet, and of course by asking any of the Early Years team.

You will be invited into school throughout the year for a variety of events, such as Stay and Play sessions and curriculum meetings. We aim to schedule these on different days and at different times to give everyone the best chance to attend. Wherever possible, we will provide plenty of notice. Dates for the Autumn term will be shared separately once the children have settled.
