English - On Monday, we will write New Year's resolution sentences using correct punctuation, including a capital letter and a full stop. We will read a range of riddles and discuss how the hardest clues come first and the easiest clue comes at the end. We will write our own animal riddles for others to guess.



Maths -

Year 1 - Time - We will be learning the days of the week and the months of the year. We will compare durations of events, measure and compare time in seconds.

Year 2 - Statistics - We will be interpreting simple tables, block graphs and pictograms. We will transfer data from one form to another.

Phonics [Y1] - We will be recapping and consolidating the 'ai', 'ow', 'igh' and 'ee' phonemes: ay [tray], ou [mouth], ie [pie], and ea [leaf]. Our tricky words are **Mr, Mrs, people**

Spelling [Y2] - We will be revising the 's' sound spelled as 'c' in nice, the 'n' sound spelled as 'kn' and 'gn' and the 'r' sound spelled as wr.

Science - We will be grouping animals based on visible characteristics.



Geography - We will be locating the four countries of the United Kingdom.

PE - Gymnastics

Music - We will be creating short sounds with varied dynamics that represent an animal.

RE - We will be understanding that people have different jobs.
