

Spelling [Y2] - We will be learning how to spell words with the wr phoneme at the beginning, eq, wriggle, wren. These words are often associated with a twisting action.


Maths -

Year 1 - Fractions - We will be finding one half of a shape and object, recognising, naming and finding one quarter of shape and objects. Capacity and Volume - We will be using language

to describe, compare and measure volume and capacity.

Year 2 - Geometry 2-D and 3-D shapes - We will be identifying, naming and describing shapes according to their properties.

Science - We will be grouping materials based on their properties (absorbency).
