English - We will complete a *role on the wall* activity based on the main character to create interest in the classic story *Peter Rabbit*. The children will record what they know, what they want to know, and what they have learned about Peter. Key vocabulary will be taught to support the children's understanding of words in context.

Maths -

Year 1 - Geometry (Position and Direction) - We will be describing whole and half turns and describing position and direction.

Year 2 - Multiplication and Division - We will be understanding multiplication as repeated addition, halving simple two-digit even numbers and sharing with no remainder.

Phonics [Y1] - We will be recapping and consolidating the phonemes: ai [train], ay [day], a-e [made] and a [acorn]. New learning: ey [grey], eigh [neigh] and ea [steak]

Our tricky words are **gone, were**

Science - We will be classifying a variety of minibeasts.

Spelling [Y2] - We will be adding -ing, -ed, -er, -est and -y to one syllable words e.g. hum - hummed/humming.



History - We will explore monarchy by finding out about King Charles III.

PE - Cricket skills
Under arm throwing skills.

Music - We will be creating a simple soundscape using dynamic changes.

PSHE - Being My Best - 'What helps us stay healthy?'

Art - This half term, we will be completing an art project with Mrs Govender.

RE - We will be considering how symbols can reflect a message or a set of values.
