Maths

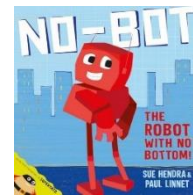
Year 1 - Fractions - We will be recognising whole split into two equal parts, find half of even numbers, recognise, find and name one quarter.

Year 2 - Money - We will be exchanging coins with the same value, partitioning, money, knowing how much more can be spent and making combinations of the same amount.

Phonics [Y1] - We will be recapping and consolidating the 'ee' phonemes: ee [sheep], y [baby] and e [remind]
Our tricky words are **small, great, before.**

Science - As it was such a lovely weather last week we went outside for our science lesson, focusing on observation skills. So this week we will be completing the stickiness investigation that was initially planned last week. Lots of sticky fun!

Spelling [Y2] - We will be learning that the -e at the end of the root word is dropped before -ing, -ed, -er, -est, -y or any other suffix beginning with a vowel letter is added. The exception to this is the word *being*.



Geography - We will be understanding how the weathers changes with each season.

PE - Kicking skills

Music - Theme - Under the Sea - We will be interpreting symbols to demonstrate a pitch pattern.
