English - We will be introduced to a new mystery book where we will make predictions, write questions and explore the characters by creating thought bubbles. We will be learning how to use the apostrophe for contraction e.g, have not - haven't.



Maths -

Year 1 - Multiplication and Division - We will be solving multiplication problems. We will be identifying equal parts and halving numbers to 10.

Year 2 - Place Value - We will continue to place numbers on a number line and round numbers to the nearest 10.

Phonics [Y1] - We will be recapping and consolidating the phonemes: u [music], ow [snow], ie [chief] and ea [bread]. Our tricky words are **laughed, because, different.**

Spelling [Y2] - We will be learning about homophones. A homophone means two or more words having the same pronunciation but different meanings or spellings e.g. great/grate.

Science - We will be recognising that the shape of some solid objects can be changed.



Geography - We will be investigating daily weather patterns.

PE - Kicking skills
Over arm throwing skills.

Music - Theme - Under the Sea - We will be exploring tempo changes through movement.

PR SHE - Rights and Responsibilities

DT - We will be practising the skills of joining two pieces of material by using stapling and whip stitch.

Chinese New Year - We will be learning about the traditions of Chinese New Year and how it is celebrated.
