English - This week, we will be studying our fiction book *George and the Dragon*. We will explore the characters and think carefully about how they feel and what they might be thinking.

We will also write questions that we would like to ask the dragon, using our SPaG skills from last week.

Phonics [Y1] - We will be learning the phonemes: er [fern], ch [school], ch [chef] a [wand] and a [acorn]. Our tricky words are any, eyes, friends.


**Spelling [Y2]** - We will be learning about homophones. A homophone means two or more words having the same pronunciation but different meanings e.g. see and sea.

## Maths -

Year 1 - Fractions - We will be finding equal parts, fractions of 2D shapes and recognising and naming one half of a shape or objects.

Year 2 - Addition and Subtraction - We will be subtracting a 2-digit number from a 2-digit number, deriving and reasoning about bonds to 20 and adding 3 single digit numbers.

**Science** – We will be describing the properties of materials.





**Geography** - We will be investigating how we feel about our playground.

**PE** - Dance including Samba.

Music - Sound Patterns (Fairy Tales) - We will experiment with creating different sounds using a single instrument.

PRSHE - What is the same and different about us?

DT - We will be designing a Christmas card including a slider or a lever (Y1) and a slider and a lever (Y2).





**RE** - We will be understanding how light is used as a symbol.
