Phonics

Year 1 - we will be revisiting the graphemes oy (enjoy), ir (girl), ue (oo - blue), ue (y/oo - cue) and aw (claw)

Science

We will be describing a variety of animals.

History

We will be finding out how schools have changed over time. We will continue to enjoy playing in our school role-play area.

Maths

Year 1 - we will be counting to and back from 100, comparing two numbers within 50, ordering three numbers within 20 and adding 10 to identify 10 more

Reception - we will be partitioning numbers up to 10 into two parts and working on recalling some addition and subtraction facts up to 10

Year 1 - wool wrapping

Reception - exploring with clay
