UKS2 Autumn Term 1 2025

Choose from the following exciting cross-curricular projects to complete over the half term. Each project links to a different subject and includes an optional extension activity.

Projects are due in by Monday 6th October, these can either be brought into school or emailed to the home learning addresses found on the class pages.

1. History – Census Detectives

Project Title: Who Lived Here Before?

Use historical census data (from 1901 or 1911) to investigate who lived in an area of the UK of your choice. Create a profile of a family: names, jobs, ages, and household size. Present findings as a fact file or a mini biography.

Extension: Compare with today's census data and reflect on changes.

2. Geography – Exploring the Alps

Project Title: Adventure in the Alps

Research the location, climate, and countries that the Alps span. Create a travel brochure or digital presentation for a family holiday to the Alps. Include activities like skiing, hiking, and local foods.

Extension: Compare the Alps to a UK mountain range.

3. Maths – Place Value Challenge

Project Title: Place Value Puzzle Book

Create a booklet of place value puzzles and games for younger children. Include activities like digit cards, rounding challenges, and number comparisons. Use numbers up to 1,000,000 and include decimals.

Extension: Add a quiz with answers and explanations.

4. English – Write a Sci-Fi Short Story

Project Title: Mission to Planet Zog

Write a science fiction story set in space or the future. Include imaginative settings, alien characters, and a problem to solve. Use descriptive language and dialogue.

Extension: Illustrate your story or record an audiobook version.

5. PSHE – Relationships Reflection

Project Title: Friendship Matters

Create a poster or comic strip showing what makes a good friend. Include examples of kindness, empathy, and resolving conflicts. Interview a family member about their friendships growing up.

Extension: Write a poem or song about friendship.

6. PE – Netball and Football Skills Diary

Project Title: My Sports Journal

Keep a diary of your practice sessions in netball and football. Record skills practiced, progress made, and goals set. Include diagrams or photos of techniques.

Extension: Create a mini training plan for a younger sibling.

7. Science – Mixtures and Separation

Project Title: Kitchen Chemistry

Investigate mixtures at home (e.g., salt water, sand and rice). Try separating them using sieving, filtering, or evaporation. Record your method, results, and conclusions.

Extension: Create a video tutorial or experiment guide.

8. RE – The Journey of Hajj

Project Title: Pilgrimage Passport

Research the stages of Hajj and create a "passport" booklet. Include drawings, facts, and reflections for each stage. Explain the significance of each part of the pilgrimage.

Extension: Compare Hajj to another religious pilgrimage.
