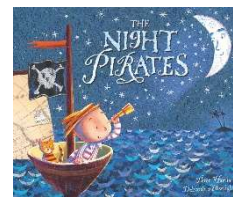
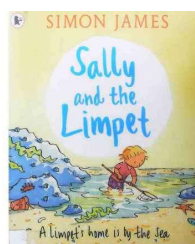
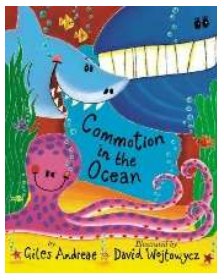
Dear Parents and Carers,

Through our Geography learning, the children will explore the coast, learning about different geographical features including land and water. We will also discuss how and why people visit different places for different reasons, including seaside locations.

In Science, we will investigate materials and our senses, helping the children understand the world around them through hands-on exploration.

In Design and Technology (DT), we will be exploring food. The children will take part in making "A Feast for a Pirate," where they will prepare and enjoy some pirate-themed food.

To celebrate our topic, children are invited to dress up as a pirate on Friday 3rd July. We are looking forward to a fun-filled day of pirate activities!
